With up to five locations now in place this will be a more complex arrangement than last year.

Michelle has undertaken our PR and publicity role and her input and experience will be greatly missed. # **Chair Donations**

This time last year we just had Sharon's chair and now we have the funding in place for a further seven bringing our total to eight. These have been donated by one private donor, two 1 1 K residents, the Ladies of Variety, the Rotary Club of Jersey, the Association of Jersey Charities and a 'joint venture' with the Jersey Cheshire Home. We are incredibly grateful to all these donors who have expressed their support for our charity in such a generous fashion.

Of the new chairs, two will be for use by children and four will have a special mechanism that allows tilting for extra postural support.
